

Counsellor & Support Positions for a Couple

Do you have a desire to use your skills in a specifically Christian setting?

Cross Roads Christian Community Trust has been working with people in need since 1993, and has operated a residential programme for those with life-controlling problems, (FreedomLife - Te Nikau) and a counselling centre since 1999 in Paraparaumu, on the Kapiti Coast.

We are looking for a couple, at least one of whom will **have general or addiction counselling** qualifications and experience.

The counsellor(s) will be able to competently counsel, facilitate small groups, have leadership skills, and as Programme Manager/Counsellor, be able to cover for the Director from time to time. Ideally you would have the energy and vision to take the lead of this work in due course.

Counselling qualifications and experience are essential. Experience in addiction work specifically would be helpful, but not essential, as we take a whole of life approach to recovery, dealing with many background issues (including relationships, grief, abuse, rejection, depression, etc.)

The other person will be able to perform a variety of caring, administration, leadership or support roles, dependent on skills, and available time.

As this programme is faith-based, applicants will be competent and comfortable in working from this perspective, as appropriate.

One position is paid, the other voluntary.

This is a live-on situation, with the remuneration package made up of one salary, accommodation, and power.
